At a Glance:

- *Transfers transactions from one QuickBooks file to another QuickBooks file with minimum effort*
- *Merge Data without erasing or overwriting existing data*
- *Transfer work done at home, a client office or other locations to the 'main' file*
- *Data can be transferred by network connection, e-mail, or removable disk*

Why was the *Data Transfer Utility* developed?

This product was developed because there was no easy way to transfer transactions from one QuickBooks file to another QuickBooks file.

Who is Your Target Market and Why?

This product is for anyone who needs to transfer transactions from one QuickBooks file to another QuickBooks file. Our customers include end-users, QuickBooks Pro Advisors, Consultants and CPA's. It can be used to merge files, split files, transfer data from file to file (Ex: A sales office to a main office), transfer data from a laptop or remote location to the office computer, to send and receive data from a client and more; the uses are endless.

We have customers in all 50 states and about a dozen foreign countries.

How does *Data Transfer Utility* Work?

The program was developed using Intuits' Software Development Kit (SDK). Using XML technology, the tool can quickly and easily transfer transactions from one QuickBooks file to another. Included with the tool are reports that will show you what has been exported and imported, including a report that details transactions that were not imported and the error information.

Users select the transaction and/or lists types that they want to transfer and click a few buttons to export from the Source file and import the data to the Destination file. The data being transferred can be limited by date range, reference number range, name, and many other filters. Before the data is imported, it is extensively validated by the SDK to make sure that it is complete and that it conforms to QuickBooks' business rules.

Who is your competition and how does the **Data Transfer Utility** differ?

The Data Transfers Utility's main competition is a fast typist. The transfer utility's main advantages are speed and accuracy because we use the XML technology and Intuit's SDK.

A mini customer case study:

*I wanted to let you know that I had GREAT SUCCESS with your **Data Transfer Utility** with a QuickBooks client that was working with two separate QuickBooks files for different parts of their business. When they realized they could no longer operate like this, they went looking for a Consultant to help them.... QuickBooks Integration:

The **Data Transfer Utility** can export/import almost all of the QuickBooks transactions (invoice, bill etc.); and list (accounts, customers, vendors etc.) types. Payroll checks and tax liability checks cannot be transferred by the utility at this time. See the tables at <http://www.q2q.us/dtudatatypes.htm> for what can and cannot be transferred.

Installation & Setup:

The program can be installed in a couple of minutes or less. We have video demonstrations available at <http://www.q2q.us/dtuvideos.htm> that showcases how the program works, including a short video that shows exactly how to install the program.

After installing this program (or any other QuickBooks integrated application) you need to make an "initial" connection to the QuickBooks files that will be used. In the "initial" connection process the QuickBooks administrator gives permission for the transfer utility program to access the data in the QuickBooks file and can set certain conditions and restrictions on this access. The transfer utility cannot access any data in a QuickBooks file until the administrator has given this permission. Our site offers many videos for assistance; users can refer to Video Number 2 at <http://www.q2q.us/dtuvideos.htm> on how to make the "initial" connection to the QuickBooks files. The QuickBooks administrators permission can be revoked or changed at any time by clicking Edit>Preferences>Integrated Application Preferences inside of QuickBooks.

An experienced QuickBooks user can be making transfers within a few minutes after installing the program. Refer to Video Number 3 at <http://www.q2q.us/dtuvideos.htm> for a demonstration of the actual data transfer process.

Demonstrations & Trials

We offer a free trial version of the **Data Transfer Utility** program. The trial is the full version of the program with a limitation on the volume of data that can be transferred in each transfer pass. The free trial is un-timed and can be used as long as needed. When the program is purchased, we e-mail a software key that removes the demo limitations and allows full use of the program.

We also have self-running videos that show how to download, install, and use the program. These videos are located at <http://www.q2q.us/dtuvideos.htm> on our site.

Pricing, Support, Enhancements & Updates:

The price of the program runs from \$79 to \$129 depending on the version purchased. We have versions that work with QuickBooks 2002 through 2006. All versions work with U.S. QuickBooks and certain versions also work with QuickBooks from Canada, United Kingdom and Australia. Existing users can purchase upgrades at a discounted price. The software also requires that you have either Microsoft Access 2000-2003 or the Microsoft Access 2000 Runtime engine; this can be downloaded from our "How to Buy" (www.q2q.us/download.htm) page at **no cost**.

We frequently update the program based on user input and owners of a version can download all updates to the version they own at no additional cost.

The program works with QuickBooks Pro, Premier and Enterprise. The program cannot work with QuickBooks Basic but can work with the new 2006 Simple Start edition of QuickBooks. The program can transfer data from an Enterprise file to a Pro or Premier file, opening up even more possibilities for you or your client.

A new version is released every year, and each version can work with a minimum of 2 versions (years) of QuickBooks. We are beta testers for QuickBooks and Intuits' Software Development Kit and new versions of our product is available by the time QuickBooks is released for retail distribution.

We provide 60 days of free email support from the date of purchase. We don't normally provide telephone support but we call customers or conduct an on-line session if we cannot resolve any problems by email. The program includes a screen that allows users to click a button and send us a copy of any reports they need us to look at.

How can the Data Transfer Utility help Advisors with their clients?

This software can improve the speed and accuracy of transfers made by Advisors for clients. It also provides a solution for an Advisor to recommend to clients who are looking for a way to transfer data from one location to another. The utility is invaluable and offers so much flexibility; such as transferring information from an older version of QuickBooks to a newer version, merging off-site data to the 'main' working copy, and never miss a beat along the way.
